Prodrive recruit apprentices annually, and look for enthusiastic people who have achieved grade C and above at GCSE level, have a passion for cars and who can demonstrate these important values:

Apprentices attend Oxford and Cherwell College in Bicester, or Warwickshire College.

Apprenticeships within Prodrive take place over a period of 3 years, with the opportunity to work in a variety of departments.

Apprentices usually become full-time employees of the company and much of the competency assessment is carried out in the workplace through the collection of 'portfolio' evidence. Further training support is provided through workplace monitoring visits undertaken every 12 weeks by college staff; providing an opportunity for feedback from workshop supervisors.
