**Job title:** Body Shell Fabricator

**Department:** Motor Sport Operations

**Reporting to:** Production Manager

**Job purpose:** To meet all body shell and roll cage requirements for SWRT, GpN and Aston Martin build programmes; Fabrication and welding are the main skills along with good communication and organisation

## **Key responsibilities:**

- Using build manuals and codes of practice for guidance, build WRC shells, GpN shells and roll cages, under supervision of a senior technician.
- Have a High standard of Mig and Tig welding, ultimately have the same standard as the senior members of the department.
- Tig welding sub-assemblies for shell build programmes.
- Repair and up spec body shells as required.
- Maintain a good level of housekeeping within the department.
- Meet requirements of all internal customers, reacting to their requests, sometimes at short notice.
- Be prepared to work extra hours, sometimes at short notice, to meet delivery.
